3:00pm – We will tour the Trinity Church Boston, designated as one of the ten most important buildings in America. In continuous existence since its founding in 1733, **Trinity Church** is the third oldest Episcopal parish in Boston, after King’s Chapel (1686) and Christ Church (1722).

- Now in its 145th season, the Boston Symphony Orchestra gave its inaugural concert in 1881, realizing the dream of its founder, the Civil War veteran/businessman/philanthropist Henry Lee Higginson, who envisioned a great and permanent orchestra in his hometown of Boston. Today the BSO reaches millions of listeners through not only its concert performances in Boston and at Tanglewood, but also via the internet, radio, television, educational programs, recordings, and tours.

12:00pm – Welcome to **Stockbridge Main Street** at Christmas (Home for Christmas) made famous by **American painter and illustrator Norman Rockwell** in the 1967 painting. The Berkshires town closes portion of the street to traffic and recreates the painting annually on this date. Complete with **antique cars** parked along the street, this **festive atmosphere** is sure to get anyone into the holiday spirit. (Note: Each person receives a **Commemorative Stockbridge Button** which is their admission to Main Street.)



1:30pm – Included **Luncheon Buffet** at the **Morgan House Inn** in **Lee, MA.**

*The **Morgan House** was built as a private residence for **William Porter** in 1813. **Edwin Morgan** purchased and enlarged the home in 1853 and opened its doors to visitors arriving on incoming **stagecoaches**. Thus began the long and illustrious history of **The Morgan House Inn**.*

3:00pm – Depart for **Sayre, Comfort Stop** on the way
