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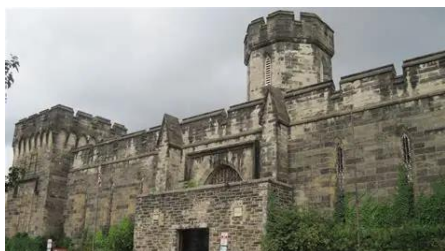

1:30pm – 2:15pm – Guided tour of Eastern State Penitentiary -
This 45-minute guided tour and discussion is led by an Eastern State educator and explores the penitentiary's complex history, its ongoing relevance to contemporary social issues, and sets the stage for conversation about the role of prisons in society today.

2:15pm – 3:30pm – Enjoy one of the many exhibits for our remaining time. Eastern State's critically acclaimed exhibits

illuminate the penitentiary's history, uncover the stories of people who lived and worked inside its walls, and deepen understanding of the criminal justice system in America. Learn more about Jewish Life at Eastern State Penitentiary and consider the impact of mass incarceration with companion exhibits Prisons Today and The Big Graph.

9:00am – visit **Independence Hall** for their open house.



- In 1776, the Second Continental Congress signed the Declaration of Independence here. Eleven years later, in the same room, delegates to the Constitutional Convention created and signed an enduring framework of government - the United States Constitution. Although known today as Independence Hall, the building was constructed to be the Pennsylvania State House. It once housed all three branches of Pennsylvania's colonial government.

9:30am-9:45am – walk two-blocks to the **Museum of the American Revolution**.

9:30am – 11:30am – Enjoy the **Living History Exhibitions** outside of the **Museum of the American Revolution** at your leisure.

*- Step back in time and experience Philadelphia in the autumn of 1776! During **this living history event**, you'll meet the diverse residents of the city that served as the headquarters of the Revolution. Haggle merchants and artisans at a market; listen in as neighbors debate politics and loyalties; and decide whether you will enlist with the Philadelphia Associators to support Washington's Army, maintain your loyalty to the King, or play both sides!*

11:30am – 2:00pm – Included admission to the **Museum of the American Revolution** and enjoy lunch with an included **\$20 voucher** to on-site café during our time there.

2:00pm – 4:00pm – Our two personal tour guides are going to take on a (6-8 block walk) making stops at **Carpenters Hall** – (we will get to go inside for a short visit), **Liberty Bell visit**, we will also see the **President's House** – (George Washington and John Adams lived at this residence at times during their Presidency). We will meet our bus at the **National Constitution Center** and travel to the **Betsy Ross house**, also visiting **Elfreth Alley**, and **Christ Church**.
